€2.5 M of regional development subsidy granted to Sky Aircraft

On 4 December 2008, the Secretary of State for Regional Planning, Hubert Falco decided to grant a 2.5 million Euros regional development subsidy to SKY AIRCRAFT.

This decision by the State follows the installation on the Chambley-Bussières site, since the end of November, of the first 40 engineers of the GECI International subsidiary dedicated to the development, production and marketing of the Skylander, a light twin turboprop aircraft intended for the freight, humanitarian and short distance transport markets, with the first examples due for delivery from 2011.

The GECI International group, supported by the French state, the Lorraine Region and the local authorities, intends to play a major role in the new French aeronautic sector with this installation in Lorraine.
