Dubai Air Show : GECI International signs a Letter of intent for 10 Skylander SK-105 with Global Aerospace Logistics LLC

After its first commercial achievements in Le Bourget Paris Air Show, the Dubai Air Show confirms the growing level of interest of international operators for the Skylander SK-105.



GECI International announces the signature, by its subsidiary Sky Aircraft, of a Letter of Intent for the delivery of 10 aircrafts with the Global Aerospace Logistics LLC Company, located in Abu Dhabi (UAE).

Global Aerospace Logistics, supported by the UAE Government, is one of the leading Emirati groups specializing in the aerospace sector. Global Aerospace Logistics has the ambition to become the Middle East's leading provider for logistics, support, maintenance, training and aircraft trading. Global Aerospace Logistics is a subsidiary of Emirates Advanced Investments (EAI), set up in 2006, whose strategy consists in investing on projects and developments with high value added for the benefit of UAE

Global Aerospace Logistics selected the bulk cargo configuration of the Skylander SK-105, for its flexibility and its capacity to be converted for passengers transport, freight, combi, maritime surveillance or medical evacuations.

The Skylander SK-105 is a new generation twin turbo propeller, modern, multipurpose, with a payload of 3 tons in its 28m³ cabin, capable to operate in extreme environments and to exploit short and unpaved runways.

The Skylander SK-105 is unique on the market in terms of volume cabin, payload, range and flexibility. It meets the operators' requirements for passengers and cargo transportation: commuters, tourists, sanitary evacuation, humanitarian missions, freight, combi, express freight, perishable goods, surveillance, airdrop...

Sky Aircraft plans to produce 1 500 aircrafts, between 2012 and 2028, in its Chambley industrial site, in the Lorraine region of France. This site is designed to produce 9 aircrafts per month from 2015, the return on investment of the Skylander program being around 180 aircrafts.

The Letter of intent signed with Global Aerospace Logistics plans the delivery of the first aircraft in 4th quarter 2012, of three other aircrafts in 2013 and of the last six aircrafts in 2014.

This order concludes a very positive Dubai Air Show fit Sky Aircraft. The commercial staff of Sky Aircraft received a lot of civilian and military delegations, coming from Middle-East, Asia or Africa, all very interested by the Skylander SK-105 and its performance.

The Skylander's c customer sales book has reached more than 600 aircrafts, more than 300 of which are being negotiated.

The intense interest shown for the Skylander SK-105 and for the F406 of Reims Aviation during the Dubai Air Show demonstrates the relevance of GECI International positioning and the commercial potential of its aircrafts offer.
